Peace Treaty for Korea

IAW

Supporting Korean women in their efforts to build confidence towards Peace and Reconciliation on the Korean Peninsula;

Persuaded that, in order to avoid further escalation of current tensions risking nuclear disaster, direct negotiations leading to a peace treaty that gives North Korea the security it needs for survival and the North Korean people a chance to return to the community of states, would be the best and only way of building confidence;

calls on the UN to work towards a package of security guarantees which

- scale back or suspend the U.S.- South-Korean military exercises and
- delay the deployment of new U.S. military equipment such as the THAAD missile to South Korea
